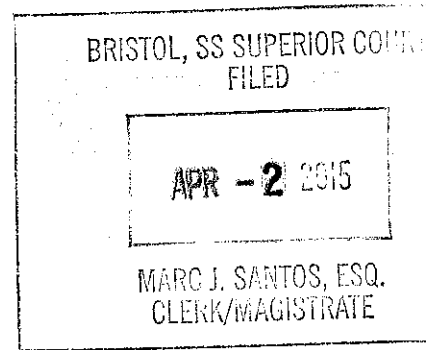

AT THE END OF THE COMMONWEALTH'S CASE**


Aaron Hernandez, defendant in the above-captioned criminal case, hereby moves this Court, pursuant to Mass. R. Crim. P. 25(a), the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution, and Article XII of the Massachusetts Declaration of Rights, for a required finding of not guilty on Counts One and Two, respectively, on the grounds that viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the prosecution, no rational jury could find every essential element of the crimes charged beyond a reasonable doubt. The grounds for this motion are set forth more fully in

the accompanying memorandum of law.




