P. 14(a)(6), jointly request that this Honorable Court issue a protective order prohibiting the defendant from providing, duplicating, or otherwise distributing copies of any records, reports, transcripts, photographs, audio or video recordings, and any other materials listed in the Commonwealth's Discovery Notices I-VII (Bates Stamp 1-19708) and any subsequent materials, except in connection with the defense of these criminal cases.


Here, the parties jointly request that this Court enter the attached Protective Order. The agreed-upon order will not prejudice the defense of the criminal indictments. The parties agree that this limited order will help ensure that the integrity of the criminal trial is not compromised and further the administration of justice.


