Aaron Hernandez, defendant in the above-captioned criminal case, hereby moves this Court, pursuant to Mass. R. Crim. P. 25(a), the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution, and Article XII of the Massachusetts Declaration of Rights, for a required finding of not guilty on Counts One and Two, respectively, on the grounds that viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the Commonwealth, no rational jury could find every essential element of the crimes charged beyond a reasonable doubt. In support thereof, the defendant relies upon his previously-filed Memorandum of Law in Support of Defendant's Motion for Required Finding of




